

**EXHIBIT 1**

Rastafarianism is a recognized religion and marijuana operates as a sacrament and plays a necessary and central role in the practice of Rastafarianism. A Rastafarian's personal possession and use of marijuana is a valid religious defense to possession of marijuana. The defendant has presented evidence that he is a practicing Rastafarian and that in accordance with his religious beliefs, he possessed marijuana for sacramental use. It is solely for you to determine whether a defendant's religious beliefs are sincerely held.

A Rastafarian's personal possession of marijuana for use in his religion is not a defense to the crime of possession of marijuana with intent to distribute. It is not a defense to the crime of conspiracy to manufacture (cultivate) marijuana plants with intent to distribute.
